

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING WATER, SEWER AND SOLID WASTE FEES AND CHARGES AS PROVIDED BY THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ADA, OKLAHOMA.**

**WHEREAS**, the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada, Oklahoma provides that the fees and charges for various City functions and services shall be set by motion and/or resolution of the City of Ada, Oklahoma; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, has determined that the fees and charges as set forth in this resolution are fair and reasonable.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Ada, Oklahoma: **THAT** the following fees and charges are hereby established in the City of Ada, Oklahoma:

**SECTION ONE.**

**WATER RATES**

**(a)** The rates for water furnished by the City **within the corporate limits** of the City shall be as follows:

**SECTION TWO.**

**SEWER SERVICE CHARGES**

For the purpose of providing funds for the maintenance of sanitary sewage system of the City and for other purposes, there is hereby fixed and established, charges for the use of the sanitary sewer system to be levied against each respective user thereof.

\* The purpose of the Sewer System Fund is to provided funding for the future replacement or upgrade of the sewer treatment facility and/or provide funding for water, sewer, and solid waste CIP deemed necessary.

\*\* The purpose of the Environmental Project Fund is to provide funding for imposed environmental mandates and/or provide funding for water, sewer and solid waste CIP deemed necessary.

Commercial customers with water usage of approximately 10,000 cubic feet per month may make an application to be exempt and not be billed for more than the maximum charge established above, for commercial users. Such application shall be submitted to the City Manager for his review in such form as he may provide. To qualify for the exemption, the customer must establish to the satisfaction of the City Manager that more than 75% of the average monthly water usage does not flow into the city's sewer or storm water drainage system.

**SECTION THREE:**

**GARBAGE COLLECTION CHARGES**

(a) A monthly garbage collection fee shall be charged and collected by the City for the collection and disposition of garbage and trash **in the residential district**, in accordance with the following schedule:

**SECTION FOUR:**

**LANDFILL RATES AND CHARGES**

All users of the City of Ada Landfill shall be charged the following landfill rates as set forth below:

- (a) Persons residing within the corporate limits of the City of Ada and commercial users whose principal place of business is located within the corporate limits of the City of Ada (must show personal or business identification which provides proof of the city residence or business location) shall pay the sum of \$60.00 per ton with a minimum charge of \$15.00
- (b) Persons residing outside the corporate limits of the City of Ada and commercial users whose principal place of business is located outside the corporate limits of the City of Ada shall pay the sum of \$60.00 per ton with a minimum charge of \$15.00
- (c) There shall be a 50% additional charge collected for any loads received at the landfill which are not properly secured in accordance with state statutes and city ordinances to cover the expenses involved in cleaning the approaches to the landfill caused by improperly secured loads.
- (d) Forty percent (40%) of all collections under this Section shall be allocated to the Solid Waste Fund, whose purpose is to provide solutions to solid waste problems and/or provide funding for water, sewer and solid waste CIP deemed necessary.

**SECTION FIVE:**

**BRUSH AND MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES**

Items placed by the curb on right-of-way will be picked up for hauling to the City landfill. The following charges will apply to these items: (Quadrants and Schedule Defined as per Exhibit A)

- 1. **Grapple Service Program:**

- a. All residential solid waste customers: <sup>1)</sup> \$ 3.50 per month
  - 1. Amount covers up to 4 cubic yards or 3 household items, except items that use Freon (see 1.b below)
  - 2. There is an additional charge for grapple truck service when out of the designated quadrant pickup schedule (see 1.b. below)

<sup>1)</sup>(of which \$1.75 per month will be allocated to the Solid Waste Development Fund)

- b. Grapple Service Program rates when out of Quadrant or over minimum allowed or use Freon:

1. Grapple Truck:

a. Brush, Limbs and shrubbery, per cubic yard

- 1. In Quadrant cubic yard over minimum allowed \$ 5.00 per cubit yard
- 2. Outside of Quadrant \$ 40.00 minimum plus \$ 6.25 per cu. Yrd.

b. Household items (not appliances)

1. In Quadrant

- a. Over three items \$ 2.00 per item
- b. Large items which require front-end loader \$ 20.00 per load

2. Outside of Quadrant: (will call)

- a. Minimum charge- up to 3 items \$ 40.00
- b. Over three items \$ 60.00 per item
- c. Large items which require front-end loader \$ 100.00 per load

c. Appliances

1. Containing Freon:

- a. With removal certification \$ 10.00 per item
- b. Without removal certification \$ 30.00 per item

2. Construction Debris:

Contract with hauler or haul yourself

3. Lawn Clippings:

Not picked up. (See Item 2.a below)

4. Tire Fees:

Passenger up to 17.5 inches:

- Without rim \$ 1.00 per tire
- With rim \$ 5.00 per tire

Passenger/ Trucks exceeding 17.5 inches up to 24.5 inches:

- Without rim \$ 3.50 per tire
- With rim \$ 10.00 per tire

**(Tires larger than those listed are not accepted)**

**2. Items delivered to the landfill by customer (not grapple service program):**

(a) Residential trees, brush and lawn clippings (no lumber, metal, glass, plastic or other material)

(Does not include commercial or development / builder use or persons residing outside the corporate limits of the City of Ada)

- If properly secured \$ 30.00 per ton with \$15.00 minimum
- If NOT properly secured \$ 60.00 per ton with \$15.00 minimum

(b) Appliances containing Freon

- 1. With removal certification Weight based fee only (See Section 4)
- 2. Without removal certification \$ 20.00 plus weight based fee (See Section 4)

(b) Tire Fees

same as noted in Section 5.1.b above plus weight based fee (See Section 4)

**SECTION SIX:**

**LATE FEES**

A late fee will be assessed on all past due balances. The fee will be calculated at ten percent (10%) of the outstanding water balance. Partial payments will be applied in the following order: late fees, garbage, sewer, and then water.

The effective dates of this resolution shall be as of the date of passage; however, said resolution contains specific effective dates for future rate increases, with said increases being effective on the specific date stated herein.
